Abstract:

Collection of Indiana University South Bend Chancellor Kenneth Perrin materials. Dates range from 1997 to 2002. This collection is a view into the five-year term of Kenneth Perrin who served as Chancellor of Indiana University South Bend. It details the installation of Chancellor Perrin, the Student Satisfaction and Priorities Survey that he commissioned in 1998, the Chancellor's Report of 1997 – 2001, campus and community reaction to his tenure, and correspondence of the Chancellor. In addition there are materials from the search for Chancellor immediately before and immediately after Perrin's tenure.

Scope and Content Note:

The material is contained in thirteen folders arranged in roughly chronological order. The installation of Chancellor Perrin is documented through programs, photographs, a video cassette, official ribbons worn at the ceremony, and IU South Bend newsletters that provide a summary and the text of Perrin's installation address, which detailed his agenda for the future of the IUSB community. Chancellor's Staff Meeting minutes from July 15, 1997 through January 6, 1998 and correspondence from the years 1997, 1998, and 2001 are included. The bulk of the correspondence relates to the "Declaration of Common Purpose" (April, 2001),
