### Scope and Content Note

Collection includes the two Indiana University South Bend student publications, *Realm* and *Analecta*, from 1965 to 1981, as well as some miscellaneous materials on each publication. The publication *Realm* became *Analecta* sometime in between 1967 and 1972. Each of these publications is in booklet form and includes poems, short stories, essays, and artwork written by students of IU South Bend. The collection includes *Realm* for the years 1965 to 1967, and an undated volume. *Realm* seems to have been published once a year. The volumes of *Analecta* begin in 1972 and go to the present. *Analecta* was published twice a year – first in Spring, and then in Fall in its early years, and then in 1978 it began to be an annual publication. There are also miscellaneous materials for each publication, including memos, calls for submission, and review articles from student newspaper *The Preface*. *Analecta* changed its name briefly to *Current* in 1991, until 1994. In 1996 the student publication's name was *Visceral Pagoda*. In 1997 it again became *Analecta*. The publication (like the student newspaper, *The Preface*), is produced with student activities funds and comes under the supervision of the Publications Board, in part with the English Department.
