Scope and Content Note

Collection includes the student publication, *Undergraduate Research Journal*. The *Undergraduate Research Journal* began in 1998. Its mission statement reads: "The *Undergraduate Research Journal* is an interdisciplinary journal of undergraduate research written, edited, peer-reviewed, and published by the students of Indiana University South Bend. Submissions from all disciplines are accepted. Papers must be written by IUSB undergraduates, whether independently or for a class, and must be communicated to the journal by a faculty member from the appropriate discipline." Its first volume in 1998 was entitled *Anansi's Gourd* (with the *Undergraduate Research Journal* as its subtitle), and subsequent years have been entitled *Undergraduate Research Journal*. The publication (like the student newspaper, <u>The Preface</u>), is produced with student activities funds and comes under the supervision of the Publications Board, in part with the English Department.
