WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Currently employed faculty and staff
- Currently enrolled students in good standing

HOW DO I GET A CARD?

- Fill out the attached application
- Present application with current campus ID to home library

NOTE: The home library has final authority to issue or deny reciprocal borrowing privileges.

HOW DO I CHECK OUT MATERIALS?

Borrowers **must** present:

- ALI Borrower's Card
- Current campus ID
- Photo ID with current address

NOTE: Some lending libraries may issue a local library card.

WHAT ARE MY BORROWING PRIVILEGES?

- Privileges are granted for **up to one year** (expiring on or before June 30)
- Privileges and loan periods are determined by the lending (host) library
